• **September 14, 15, 16 (3 nights) – Russell Pond, Baxter State Park** – lean-to # 3 (6) and lean-to #4 (6) – a 7.2 mile backpack trip

note: Contact Friends of Baxter to reserve a place; the cost of a lean-to is \$30/night.
